Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing
Section 2-105 as follows:

Sec. 2-105. Member. "Member": <u>Until the effective date of</u> <u>this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, members</u> <u>Members</u> of the General Assembly of this State including persons who enter military service while a member of the General Assembly and any person serving as Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Treasurer, Comptroller, or Attorney General for the period of service in such office.

14 Until the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, any Any person who has served for 10 or more 15 16 Clerk or Assistant Clerk of the House vears as of 17 Representatives, Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Senate, or any combination thereof, may elect to become a 18 19 member of this system while thenceforth engaged in such service by filing a written election with the board. Any person so 20 electing shall be deemed an active member of the General 21 22 Assembly for the purpose of validating and transferring any service credits earned under any of the funds and systems 23
