- Section 5. The Retailers' Occupation Tax Act is amended by 4
- 5 changing Section 2i as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2i. Notwithstanding any other provision to the the
- contrary, any person who is required to file a bond pursuant to 8
- 9 any provision of this Act and who has continuously complied
- with all provisions of this Act for 24 or more consecutive 10
- months, shall no longer be required to comply with the bonding 11
- provisions of this Act so long as such person continues his 12
- compliance with the provisions of this Act. 13
