- 17 Section 10. The Regional Transportation Authority Act is
- amended by adding Section 3.11 as follows:

- Sec. 3.11. Free and reduced fare services. The Authority
- 21 shall provide the Department of Public Health with a monthly

1 list of all riders that receive free or reduced fares. The list shall include an individual's name, address, and date of birth. 2 3 The Department of Public Health shall, within 2 weeks after receipt of the list, report back to the Authority any 4 discrepancies that indicate that a rider receiving free or 5 6 reduced fare services is deceased. The Authority upon receipt 7 of the report from the Department of Public Health shall take appropriate steps to remove any deceased individual's name from 8 9 the list of individuals eligible under the free or reduced fare 10 programs.
