| 7 | (a) All elected and appointed trustees under Article 3 and |

| 10 | hours of initial trustee certification at a training facility |
| 11 | that is accredited and affiliated with a State of Illinois |
| 12 | certified college or university. This training must include |
| 13 | without limitation all of the following: |
| 14 | (1) Duties and liabilities of a fiduciary under Article |
| 15 | 1 of the Illinois Pension Code. |
| 16 | (2) Adjudication of pension claims. |

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(3) Basic accounting and actuarial training.

(5) The Illinois Open Meetings Act.

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(6) The Illinois Freedom of Information Act.

5 The training required under this subsection (a) must be completed within the first 2 years after the year that a 6 trustee takes office is elected or appointed under an Article 3 7 or 4 pension fund. At least 8 hours of training during the 8 9 first year of training must cover trustee ethics and the 10 fiduciary duties and liabilities of pension trustees. The 11 elected and appointed trustees of an Article 3 or 4 pension fund who are police officers (as defined in Section 3-106 of 12 this Code) or firefighters (as defined in Section 4-106 of this 13 14 Code) or are employed by the municipality shall be permitted 15 time away from their duties to attend such training without 16 reduction of accrued leave or benefit time. Active or appointed trustees serving on August 13, 2009 (the effective date of 17 Public Act 96-429) this amendatory Act of the 96th General 18 Assembly shall not be required to attend the training required 19 20 under this subsection (a).

(b) <u>Upon completion of, and in</u> In addition to, the initial trustee certification training required under subsection (a), all elected and appointed trustees under Article 3 and 4 of this Code, including trustees serving on <u>August 13, 2009 (the</u> effective date of <u>Public Act 96-429)</u> this amendatory Act of the <u>96th General Assembly</u>, shall also complete at least an 09700HB4666sam001

additional participate in a minimum of 16 hours of continuing 1 trustee education during (i) the 2 years following the date by 2 which the training required under subsection (a) must be 3 4 completed and (ii) every 2 years thereafter. At least 4 hours 5 of training during each of those years shall be devoted to trustee ethics and the fiduciary duties and liabilities of 6 pension trustees. At least 8 hours of the biennial training 7 required under this subsection (b) must be in the form of a 8 9 live lecture or classroom training forum or, if taken online, 10 must be in an interactive form with ascertainable verification of participation and learning by the trustee in the online 11 training program. The balance of biennial trustee training 12 required under this subsection (b) may take the form of 13 14 participation in other training opportunities incident to the 15 functioning of the pension board, such as participation in 16 board hearings on the award of disability or other benefits or training opportunities associated with other organizations or 17 employment that are applicable to the duties of a pension fund 18 19 trustee each year after the first year that the trustee is 20 elected or appointed.

(c) The training required under this Section shall be paidfor by the pension fund.

(d) Any board member who does not timely complete the training required under this Section is not eligible to serve on the board of trustees of an Article 3 or 4 pension fund, unless the board member completes the missed training within 6 09700HB4666sam001 -4- LRB097 15724 EFG 69917 a

1 months after the date the member failed to complete the required training. In the event of a board member's failure to 2 complete the required training, a successor shall be appointed 3 4 or elected, as applicable, for the unexpired term. A successor 5 who is elected under such circumstances must be elected at a special election called by the board and conducted in the same 6 manner as a regular election under Article 3 or 4, as 7 8 applicable.

Sec. 1-113.18. Ethics training. All board members of a 11 retirement system, pension fund, or investment board created 12 13 under this Code must attend ethics training of at least 8 hours 14 per year. The training required under this Section shall 15 include training on ethics, fiduciary duty, and investment issues and any other curriculum that the board of 16 the 17 system, pension fund, or investment retirement board 18 establishes as being important for the administration of the 19 retirement system, pension fund, or investment board. The Supreme Court of Illinois shall be responsible for ethics 20 21 training and curriculum for judges designated by the Court to 22 serve as members of a retirement system, pension fund, or 23 investment board.
