4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 5 changing Section 126.21 as follows:

Sec. 126.21. Applicability. This Part 3 shall apply to <u>the</u>
the investments and investment practices of property and
casualty insurers authorized to transact the kinds of insurance
in either or both Class 2 or Class 3 of Section 4 of this Code,
subject to the provisions of Section 126.1B.
