1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4857

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4857 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 6-701.1, 6-701.2, and 9-130 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/6-701.1) (from Ch. 121, par. 6-701.1)
7 Sec. 6-701.1.

8 (a) The construction of any township or district road
9 located within the road district.

10 (b) The construction of grade separations and approaches
11 thereto which avoid or replace grade crossings at intersections
12 of township or district roads and railroad tracks.

13 The highway commissioners of the several road districts, in
14 cooperation with the county superintendent of highways of their
15 respective counties, shall select the roads and grade
16 separations to be constructed with motor fuel tax funds. In the

1 selection of roads, preference shall be given to public school
2 bus routes and rural free delivery mail routes. The county
3 superintendent of highways, in cooperation with the respective
4 highway commissioners, shall prepare, or cause to be prepared
5 maps showing the roads and grade separations selected and shall
6 prepare the necessary plans, specifications and estimates of
7 cost of such construction, all of which shall be submitted to
8 the Department for approval. The type of construction selected
9 shall be adequate for present or reasonably anticipated traffic
10 needs as determined by the county superintendent of highways
11 and the respective highway commissioners and approved by the
12 Department.

13 The construction work provided for in this Section may be
14 done by contract ~~or day labor~~ with county or road district
15 equipment and forces as the county superintendent of highways
16 and the respective highway commissioners may determine.
17 Contracts for construction work shall be advertised for and let
18 by the county board in county unit road districts and by the
19 highway commissioner in township road districts. Contracts
20 shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder subject to the
21 approval of the county superintendent of highways or the
22 highway commissioner and such contracts also shall be subject
23 to approval by the Department. The construction work shall be
24 carried on under the immediate supervision of the highway
25 commissioner and under the general supervision of the county
26 superintendent of highways and all work upon such projects

1 shall be subject to approval by the Department.

2 ~~In any county in which a county unit road district has been~~
3 ~~created the county superintendent of highways for such county~~
4 ~~shall perform all of the functions of a highway commissioner~~
5 ~~under this Section with respect to the district roads in such~~
6 ~~county.~~

10 Maintenance of any township or district road as defined in
11 Section 2-103 or any grade separation constructed as provided
12 in Section 6-701.1, subject to the approval of the county
13 superintendent of highways and the Department.

14 Maintenance work provided for in this Section may be done
15 by contract or with county or road district equipment or forces
16 as the county superintendent of highways and the respective
17 highway commissioners may determine. If any road or grade
18 separation constructed in any road district as provided in this
19 Section is not maintained in a manner satisfactory to the
20 Department and the county, no further funds shall be expended
21 in such road district until such road or grade separation is so
22 maintained or provision for such maintenance is made.

23 Contracts for maintenance work shall be advertised for and
24 let by the county board in county unit road districts and by
25 the highway commissioner in township road districts. Contracts

1 shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder subject to the
2 approval of the county superintendent of highways or the
3 highway commissioner, and such contracts also shall be subject
4 to approval by the Department.

7 Sec. 9-130. No person, firm, corporation or institution,
8 public or private, shall ~~plow or remove or cause to be plowed~~
9 ~~or removed ice or snow from any shopping center, parking lot,~~
10 ~~commercial or institutional service area or driveway or any~~
11 ~~other public or private service area or driveway and deposit or~~
12 cause to be deposited ~~such~~ ice or snow upon a traffic lane,
13 parking area, or paved shoulder of a public highway ~~or along~~
14 ~~the shoulder or edge of a public highway. Such prohibition~~
15 ~~shall not pertain to a residential driveway or sidewalk.~~

16 Any person, firm, corporation or institution, public or
17 private, who violates this Section is guilty of a petty
18 offense.
