1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
5 Section 2-5 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/2-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 2-5)

7 Sec. 2-5. "Conviction".

8 "Conviction" means a judgment of conviction or sentence
9 entered upon a plea of guilty or upon a verdict or finding of
10 guilty of an offense, rendered by a legally constituted jury or
11 by a court of competent jurisdiction authorized to try the ~~the~~
12 case without a jury.
