6	(a) The Secretary of State may, up	oon a proclamation by the
7	Governor that a disaster exists, wai	ve fees for a duplicate
8	certificate of title, vehicle registr	ation, driver's license,
9	or State identification card if the ci	tizen provides sufficient
10	proof that he or she resides in the	declared disaster area.
11	This authority may only be exercised	for a period of 30 days
12	after the Governor files the proclamat	ion.
13	(b) The citizen shall provide t	o the Secretary written
14	documentation evidencing his or her	r residence or, if the
15	citizen has none, the Secretary shall	<u>l require the citizen to</u>
16	verify personal information curren	tly on file with the
17	Secretary of State. The citizen	must also provide an

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1 affirmation, under penalty of perjury, that the original 2 documents were lost or destroyed in the disaster. If the 3 Secretary is unable to confirm the identity of the citizen or 4 that the residence of the citizen was within the declared 5 disaster area, no document will be issued.

6 (c) If, upon review of the documentation provided by the citizen, the Secretary finds that the citizen was not entitled 7 to a waiver of fees under this Section, the Secretary is to 8 9 demand payment for services rendered within 60 days. If payment 10 for services is not made by the citizen, the Secretary may 11 cancel or revoke the duplicate certificate of title, vehicle registration, driver's license, or State identification card. 12 13 The citizen may request a hearing under Section 2-118 of the 14 Illinois Vehicle Code to contest the action of the Secretary."; 15 and

16 on page 4, line 21, after "Sections", by inserting "1-125.9,"; 17 and

18 on page 4, by inserting below line 22 the following:

19 "(625 ILCS 5/1-125.9)

20 Sec. 1-125.9. Highly restricted personal information. An 21 individual's photograph or image, signature, social security 22 number, <u>personal email address</u>, and medical or disability 23 information.
