SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/1-10.5 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that as a condition of initial eligibility for any benefits under the Code, an applicant must prove Illinois residency as prescribed by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 1-10.5 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/1-10.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 1-10.5. Proof of residency. As a condition of initial</u>
- 8 eligibility for any benefits under this Code, an applicant must
- 9 prove Illinois residency as prescribed by the Department of
- 10 Human Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family
- 11 Services.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
