1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 2.27 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.27) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.27)
- 7 Sec. 2.27. It shall be unlawful for any person to take
- 8 cottontail, jack, and swamp rabbits except with a gun or bow
- and arrow during the open season which will be set annually by
- 10 the Director between the dates of October 1st to February 28th
- 11 January 31st, both inclusive. Dogs may be used in hunting with
- 12 either gun or bow and arrow.
- 13 It shall be unlawful to take or possess more than the daily
- 14 take limit and possession limit of rabbits that will be set
- annually by the Director. Limits cannot exceed a daily take
- 16 limit of 5 rabbits or a possession limit of 10 rabbits.
- 17 The provisions of this Section are subject to modification
- 18 by administrative rule.
