The plan shall be 7 designed to relieve school districts of the administrative 8 9 burdens that impede efficiency and accompany single-program 10 funding. A school district that receives an Early Childhood Education Block Grant shall report to the State Board of 11 Education on its use of the block grant in such form and detail 12 as the State Board of Education may specify. In addition, the 13 report must include the following description for the district, 14 15 which must also be reported to the General Assembly: block 16 grant allocation and expenditures by program; population and service levels by program; and administrative expenditures by 17 program. The State Board of Education shall ensure that the 18 reporting requirements for a district organized under Article 19 20 34 of this Code are the same as for all other school districts

21 in this State.
