Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as 4 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 6 7 grants for historic preservation programs made either 8 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 9 agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 10 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or private corporation, organization, or individual. 11

12 Section 25. The sum of \$277,808, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 13 14 business on June 30, 2012, from appropriations heretofore 15 made for such purpose in Article 15, Sections 20 and 25 of 16 Public Act 97-0057, is reappropriated from the Illinois 17 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for 18 awards and grants for historic preservation programs made 19 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal 20 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 21 or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 22 private corporation, organization, or individual.
