- Section 10. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
  be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility
  Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce
  Commission for refunds.
- Section 20. The sum of \$76,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission

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- 2 telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or
- 3 the Department of State Police for the design,
- 4 implementation, operation, maintenance, or upgrade of

- 7 Section 25. The sum of \$7,300,000, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Carrier

- 11 complying with the applicable provisions of Federal
- 12 Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1 services
- 13 mandates and for administrative costs incurred by the
- 14 Illinois Commerce Commission related to administering the
- 15 program.
- 16 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
- 18 from the Transportation Regulatory Fund for ordinary and
- 19 contingent expenses to the Illinois Commerce Commission:

Section 35. The sum of \$4,450,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 15 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 16 17 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for 18 19 administrative expenses.

Section 40. The sum of \$520,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for railroad crossing improvement initiatives.
