SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Prohibits a Representative from serving more than 6 terms of office as a Representative. Prohibits a Senator from serving more than 3 terms of office as a Senator. Effective upon being declared adopted. Applies to the election of General Assembly members beginning in the first general election after the date the amendment is declared adopted.

19	the purpose of this Section if the person is elected or
20	appointed to serve any portion of the term.

23	declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois

- 2 members of the General Assembly beginning in the first general
- 3 election that occurs after that date.
