2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Jack E. 4 Cook of Elgin, who passed away on February 1, 2011; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born on September 12, 1924 in Elgin; he was 6 a life-long resident of Elgin, a graduate of the University of 7 Illinois School of Pharmacy, and the proprietor of Parkview 8 Drugs, Cook's Pharmacy, and Manor Pharmacy; and

9 WHEREAS, He was an active sponsor, manager, and coach of 10 Cook's Cardinals women's fast-pitch baseball and women's 11 hockey teams; and

12 WHEREAS, He was appointed to the Kane County Board from 13 District 20 in 1989, and won election the following year; he 14 served on the Board for 15 years, during which he also served 15 as President of the Forest Preserve District for 8 years; and

16 WHEREAS, He helped create Chicago Wilderness, a regional 17 alliance dedicated to protecting nature and enriching life; 18 today there are more than 250 organizations involved in the 19 program; and

20 WHEREAS, He was a proud veteran of World War II and the
