2           WHEREAS, Currently, numerous smartphone applications  
3 identify the location of police D.U.I. checkpoints and send  
4 warnings to drivers about the locations of the checkpoints; and

5           WHEREAS, Such programs can be used by a drunk driver to  
6 evade police sobriety checks and represent a very serious  
7 danger to the drivers of the State of Illinois and elsewhere;  
8 therefore, be it

9           RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
10 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that  
11 we urge Congress and the U.S. Department of Transportation to  
12 pass legislation that curtails the use of police-checkpoint  
13 smartphone applications in the United States; and be it further

14           RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be  
15 presented to the Secretary of the U.S. Department of  
16 Transportation and the members of the Illinois congressional  
17 delegation.
