13 WHEREAS, Known as Maurie, he did get his high school G.E.D. 14 and took college courses through the GI Bill after he left the 15 United States Army; he worked various jobs in the main post 16 office in downtown Chicago for 27 years and after retiring from 17 that job worked part-time as a messenger for Continental Bank 18 for another 15 years; and

WHEREAS, He served in the United States Army from 1941 to 1945, stationed in Alaska on the brutally cold island of Atu, the westernmost of the Aleutian Islands; and 1 WHEREAS, From the time he was a young child he was very 2 athletic; he was short but could really belt a softball; in organized competition he was known for his home run ability; he 3 was also a good swimmer and once saved a drowning child's life; 4 5 living in a somewhat tough neighborhood, Maurie learned to 6 defend himself and his younger brothers; he got into some 7 fights but claimed he did not start them, just finished them; he is an unbelievable checkers player, living up to the name he 8 9 made for himself as a child, winning tournaments; and
