1 HOUSE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, The American Psychological Association has warned 3 against the detrimental effects of violent video games on 4 adolescents; and 5 WHEREAS, Studies have showed a correlation between violent 6 video and increased attention deficit problems, games 7 violence, and addiction; and 8 WHEREAS, 72% of American households play computer or video 9 games, as reported by the Entertainment Software Association; 10 and WHEREAS, 91% of American children aged 2 to 17 play 11 12 computer or video games, as reported by the NPD Group; and 13 WHEREAS, Since 2009, there has been a 9% increase of American children aged 2 to 17 that play video games, with an 14 15 approximate 65 million children currently playing video games, 16 as reported by the NPD Group; and 17 American Psychological Association WHEREAS, The reported that, on average, boys spend 13 hours playing video 18 19 games a week and girls spend 5 hours playing video games a
