- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Natalie 4 Rosenthal Seltzer of Park Ridge and Chicago, who passed away on 5 April 28, 2012; and
- 6 WHEREAS, She was born August 12, 1921; she was a life-long 7 Chicagoan and a 35-year resident of Park Ridge; and
- 8 WHEREAS, She studied at the University of Chicago, earning 9 an A.B. degree in 1944 and a Masters degree from the School of 10 Social Service Administration in 1948; while a student at the 11 University of Chicago she met her husband of over 50 years, 12 Arthur Owen Seltzer, who was her economics instructor; and
- 13 WHEREAS, She devoted her life to helping others; she was
 14 appointed as an instructor at the University of Illinois
 15 Chicago Campus in 1956 and as Professor and Head of the
 16 Department of Medical Social Work in 1977, a position she held
 17 until 1988, when she returned to the faculty; and
- WHEREAS, In retirement, she became absorbed in her passions of travel and the arts, in particular the Lyric Opera of Chicago; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Natalie Seltzer was the daughter of Hyman and Eva
- 2 Rosenthal, who predeceased her; she is survived by her loving
