10 awarded pursuant to this Act shall be limited by a reasonable

11 and appropriate sunset date. A taxpayer shall not be entitled

to take a credit awarded pursuant to this Act for tax years

beginning on or after  $\underline{10}$   $\underline{5}$  years after the effective date of

this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly. After the

initial 10-year sunset, the General Assembly may extend the

sunset date by 5-year intervals.
