## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Section 9-230 as follows:

Sec. 9-230. Return of township or multi-township
assessment books.

9 (a) The township or multi-township assessors in counties with less than 600,000 inhabitants, based on the 2000 federal 10 decennial census, shall, on or before June 15 of the assessment 11 year, return the assessment books or workbooks to 12 the 13 supervisor of assessments. The township or multi-township 14 assessors in counties with 600,000 or more but no more than 700,000 inhabitants, based on the 2000 federal decennial 15 16 census, shall, on or before July 15 <del>October 15</del> of the 17 assessment year, return the assessment books or workbooks to the supervisor of assessments. The township or multi-township 18 19 assessors in counties with less than 3,000,000 inhabitants, but more than 700,000 inhabitants, based on the 2000 federal 20 decennial census, shall, on or before November 15 of the 21 22 assessment year, return the assessment books or workbooks to the supervisor of assessments. If a township or multi-township 23

assessor in a county with less than 3,000,000 inhabitants, but more than 600,000 inhabitants, based on the 2000 federal decennial census, does not return the assessment books or work books within the required time, the supervisor of assessments may take possession of the books and complete the assessments pursuant to law. Each of the books shall be verified by affidavit by the assessor substantially as follows:

1 assessments. The moneys collected under this subsection may be 2 used by the supervisor of assessments only for the purpose of 3 recouping costs incurred in completing the assessments.
