1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 634

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 634 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 5-2.2 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/5-2.2 new)

7 Sec. 5-2.2. Designation of trustees; Township 36 North,  
8 Range 13 East. After the April 5, 2011 consolidated election,  
9 the trustees of schools in Township 36 North, Range 13 East  
10 shall no longer be elected pursuant to the provisions of  
11 Sections 5-2, 5-2.1, 5-3, 5-4, 5-12, and 5-13 of this Code.  
12 Instead, the board of education or board of school directors of  
13 each of the elementary and high school districts that are  
14 subject to the jurisdiction of Township 36 North, Range 13 East  
15 shall appoint one of the members to serve as trustee of  
16 schools. The trustees of schools shall be appointed by each

1 board of education or board of school directors within 60 days  
2 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 97th  
3 General Assembly and shall reorganize within 30 days after all  
4 the trustees of schools have been appointed or within 30 days  
5 after all the trustees of schools were due to have been  
6 appointed, whichever is sooner. Trustees of schools so  
7 appointed shall serve at the pleasure of the board of education  
8 or board of school directors appointing them, but in no event  
9 longer than 2 years unless reappointed.

10 A majority of members of the trustees of schools shall  
11 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The  
12 trustees shall organize by appointing one of their number  
13 president, who shall hold the office for 2 years. If the  
14 president is absent from any meeting, or refuses to perform any  
15 of the duties of the office, a president pro-tempore may be  
16 appointed. Trustees who serve on the board as a result of  
17 appointment or election at the time of the reorganization shall  
18 continue to serve as a member of the trustees of schools, with  
19 no greater or lessor authority than any other trustee, until  
20 such time as their elected term expires.

21 Each trustee of schools appointed by a board of education  
22 or board of school directors shall be entitled to  
23 indemnification and protection against claims and suits by the  
24 board that appointed that trustee of schools for acts or  
25 omissions as a trustee of schools in the same manner and to the  
26 same extent as the trustee of schools is entitled to

1 indemnification and protection for acts or omissions as a  
2 member of the board of education or board of school directors  
3 under Section 10-20.20 of this Code.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
5 becoming law.".
