- with Section 4-1 of this Code. The requirement to engage in

- work-related activity may commence 30 days after the date of 1
- 2 application.
- (c) Financial aid under this Article shall be authorized 3
- effective 30 days after on the date of application, provided 4
- 5 that the applicant is eligible on that date.
