Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the definition of "developmental disability".

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 1-106 as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (405 ILCS 5/1-106) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 1-106)
- 8 Sec. 1-106. "Developmental disability" means a disability
- 9 which is attributable to: (a) mental retardation, cerebral
- 10 palsy, epilepsy or autism; or to (b) any other condition which
- 11 results in impairment similar to that that caused by mental
- 12 retardation and which requires services similar to those
- 13 required by mentally retarded persons. Such disability must
- originate before the age of 18 years, be expected to continue
- indefinitely, and constitute a substantial handicap.
