Amends the Pyrotechnic Use Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning definitions.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Pyrotechnic Use Act is amended by changing
Section 1 as follows:

6 (425 ILCS 35/1) (from Ch. 127 1/2, par. 127)

Sec. 1. Definitions. As used in this Act, <u>the</u> the following
words shall have the following meanings:

9 "1.3G fireworks" means those fireworks used for 10 professional outdoor displays and classified as fireworks 11 UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335 by the United States Department of 12 Transportation under 49 C.F.R. 172.101.

"Consumer distributor" means any person who distributes, offers for sale, sells, or exchanges for consideration consumer fireworks in Illinois to another distributor or directly to any retailer or person for resale.

17 "Consumer fireworks" means those fireworks that must comply with the construction, chemical composition, 18 and 19 labeling regulations of the U.S. Consumer Products Safety Commission, as set forth in 16 C.F.R. Parts 1500 and 1507, and 20 21 classified as fireworks UN0336 or UN0337 by the United States 22 Transportation under 49 C.F.R. Department of 172.101. "Consumer fireworks" shall not include snake or glow worm 23

pellets; smoke devices; trick noisemakers known as "party 1 2 poppers", "booby traps", "snappers", "trick matches", "cigarette loads", and "auto burglar alarms"; sparklers; toy 3 pistols, toy canes, toy guns, or other devices in which paper 4 5 or plastic caps containing twenty-five hundredths grains or 6 less of explosive compound are used, provided they are so 7 constructed that the hand cannot come in contact with the cap when in place for the explosion; and toy pistol paper or 8 9 plastic caps that contain less than twenty hundredths grains of 10 explosive mixture; the sale and use of which shall be permitted 11 at all times.

12 "Consumer fireworks display" or "consumer display" means 13 the detonation, ignition, or deflagration of consumer 14 fireworks to produce a visual or audible effect.

"Consumer operator" means an adult individual who is responsible for the safety, setup, and discharge of the consumer fireworks display and who has completed the training required in Section 2.2 of this Act.

"Consumer retailer" means any person who offers for sale, sells, or exchanges for consideration consumer fireworks in Illinois directly to any person with a consumer display permit.

"Display fireworks" means 1.3G or special effects fireworks or as further defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing Act.

25 "Flame effect" means the detonation, ignition, or 26 deflagration of flammable gases, liquids, or special materials

to produce a thermal, physical, visual, or audible effect before the public, invitees, or licensees, regardless of whether admission is charged, in accordance with National Fire Protection Association 160 guidelines, and as may be further defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing Act.

7 "Lead pyrotechnic operator" means an individual who is 8 responsible for the safety, setup, and discharge of the 9 pyrotechnic display or pyrotechnic service and who is licensed 10 pursuant to the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing 11 Act.

12 "Person" means individual, firm, an corporation, 13 association, partnership, company, consortium, joint venture, 14 commercial entity, state, municipality, or political 15 subdivision of a state or any agency, department, or 16 instrumentality of the United States and any officer, agent, or 17 employee of these entities.

18 "Production company" means any person in the film, digital 19 and video media, television, commercial, and theatrical stage 20 industry who provides pyrotechnic services or pyrotechnic 21 display services as part of a film, digital and video media, 22 television, commercial, or theatrical production in the State 23 of Illinois and is licensed by the Office pursuant to the 24 Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing Act.

25 "Pyrotechnic display" means the detonation, ignition, or 26 deflagration of display fireworks or flame effects to produce

visual or audible effects of a exhibitional nature before the public, invitees, or licensees, regardless of whether admission is charged, and as may be further defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing Act.

5 "Pyrotechnic distributor" means any person who distributes 6 display fireworks for sale in the State of Illinois or provides 7 them as part of a pyrotechnic display service in the State of 8 Illinois or provides only pyrotechnic services and is licensed 9 by the Office pursuant to the Pyrotechnic Distributor and 10 Operator Licensing Act.

"Pyrotechnic service" means the detonation, ignition or deflagration of display fireworks, special effects or flame effects to produce a visual or audible effect.

"Special effects fireworks" means pyrotechnic devices used 14 15 for special effects by professionals in the performing arts in 16 conjunction with theatrical, musical, or other productions 17 that are similar to consumer fireworks in chemical compositions and construction, but are not intended for consumer use and are 18 not labeled as such or identified as "intended for indoor use". 19 20 "Special effects fireworks" are classified as fireworks UN0431 21 or UN0432 by the United States Department of Transportation 22 under 49 C.F.R. 172.101.
