For all other 13 disciplinary actions against a license or recovery permit 14 holder, the Commission shall (i) notify the accused in writhing of any charges made and the time and place for a hearing on the 15 charges a least 30 days before the date set for the hearing, 16 17 (ii) direct the accused to file a"; and
