1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1948

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1948 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is
5 amended by adding Section 65 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 106/65 new)

7 Sec. 65. Provider incentives. Subject to appropriations,
8 beginning on July 1, 2011, the Department shall develop
9 incentive programs for dentists who perform dental services on
10 children covered under this Act. The incentive programs shall
11 include a pilot program in a rural and urban designated
12 shortage area that increases rates up to 64% of the
13 reimbursement level that the dentists charge for those services
14 covered. In addition, subject to appropriations, the
15 Department shall increase the rate level of dental specialty
16 services that are provided to children covered under this Act

1 to equal 64% of the dentist's usual and customary charges.
2 Subject to appropriations, the Department shall also develop
3 and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who
4 are enrolled as a "dental home" with a bonus for providing
5 services to children enrolled and covered under this Act.

6 Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is
7 amended by adding Section 54 as follows:

8 (215 ILCS 170/54 new)

9 Sec. 54. Provider incentives. Subject to appropriations,
10 beginning on July 1, 2011, the Department shall develop
11 incentive programs for dentists who perform dental services on
12 children covered under this Act. The incentive programs shall
13 include a pilot program in a rural and urban designated
14 shortage area that increases rates up to 64% of the
15 reimbursement level that the dentists charge for those services
16 covered. In addition, subject to appropriations, the
17 Department shall increase the rate level of dental specialty
18 services that are provided to children covered under this Act
19 to equal 64% of the dentist's usual and customary charges.
20 Subject to appropriations, the Department shall also develop
21 and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who
22 are enrolled as a "dental home" with a bonus for providing
23 services to children enrolled and covered under this Act.

1 Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
2 adding Section 5-5.06 as follows:

3 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.06 new)

4 Sec. 5-5.06. Provider incentives. Subject to
5 appropriations, beginning on July 1, 2011, the Department shall
6 develop incentive programs for dentists who perform dental
7 services on children covered under this Article. The incentive
8 programs shall include a pilot program in a rural and urban
9 designated shortage area that increases rates up to 64% of the
10 reimbursement level that the dentists charge for those services
11 covered. In addition, subject to appropriations, the
12 Department shall increase the rate level of dental specialty
13 services that are provided to children covered under this
14 Article to equal 64% of the dentist's usual and customary
15 charges. Subject to appropriations, the Department shall also
16 develop and implement an incentive program that rewards
17 dentists who are enrolled as a "dental home" with a bonus for
18 providing services to children enrolled and covered under this
19 Article.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
21 becoming law."
