## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3005/10 new

Amends the Governor's Office of Management and Budget Act. Provides that, beginning the first full calendar week of July in 2011, the Office shall post and maintain on the Office's official Internet website, information detailing the State's debt paydown. Sets forth the requirements for the website. Provides that the information on the website must include the assets, liabilities, and unfunded liabilities of the Teachers Retirement System, State Employees Retirement System, State Universities Retirement Systems, Judges Retirement System, and General Assembly Retirement System. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Governor's Office of Management and Budget
Act is amended by adding Section 10 as follows:

7 Sec. 10. Posting requirements; State debt paydown. Beginning the first full calendar week of July in 2011, the 8 9 Office shall post and maintain on the Office's official 10 Internet website, information detailing the State's debt paydown. This website shall be updated by the Office at least 11 once every 7 calendar days. The information on the website 12 shall include the outstanding principal amount as of any date 13 14 in the preceding 7 days, and principal or redemption and interest payments made within the preceding 7 calendar days, on 15 the State's general obligation bonds, Build Illinois bonds, 16 17 short-term borrowings issued under the Short Term Borrowing Act, and other State debt as defined in subsection (a) of 18 19 Section 9 of Article 9 of the Illinois Constitution. The information on the website also shall include the latest 20 21 available assets, liabilities, and unfunded liabilities of the 22 Teachers Retirement System, State Employees Retirement System, State Universities Retirement Systems, Judges Retirement 23

1 <u>System, and General Assembly Retirement System and</u> 2 <u>contributions made by the State to each of these retirement</u> 3 <u>systems within the preceding 7 calendar days. For each of the</u> 4 <u>pension systems, the Comptroller and the Treasurer shall</u> 5 <u>promptly provide information requested by the Office to enable</u> 6 <u>the Office to timely comply with this Section.</u>

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon8 becoming law.
