

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB2167

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 605/8.5 new

Amends the State Property Control Act. Provides that the Director of the Department of Central Management Services may sell the Thomson Correctional Center and the property on which it is located to the federal government for a reasonable price. Defines "reasonable price". Provides that the Thomson Correctional Center and the land on which it is located may not be sold to any other party by the administrator or by any other State officer or agency, unless it has first been offered for sale to the federal government. Authorizes the Director of Central Management Services to enter into any agreements and execute any documents necessary to sell the Thomson Correctional Center and the property on which it is located. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Property Control Act is amended by adding Section 8.5 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 605/8.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 8.5. Thomson Correctional Center.</u>
- is sold as a result of this amendatory Act of the 97th General
- 16 Assembly.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any
- 18 other law to the contrary, the administrator is authorized
- 19 <u>under this Section to sell the Thomson Correctional Center and</u>
- the property on which it is located to the federal government
- 21 for a reasonable price. For the purposes of this subsection
- 22 (b), "reasonable price" means an amount of money approved in
- 23 writing by the Governor that the Governor, in his or her

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- 2 considering the general economic conditions of the State, the
- 3 <u>short-term and long-term costs to the State of maintaining the</u>
- 4 property, and the State's ability to productively use the
- 5 <u>property.</u>
- 6 (c) The Thomson Correctional Center and the land on which
- 7 it is located may not be sold to any other party by the
- 8 administrator or by any other State officer or agency, unless
- 9 <u>it has first been offered for sale to the federal government as</u>
- provided in subsection (b).
- 11 (d) The administrator is authorized to enter into any
- 12 agreements and execute any documents necessary to exercise the
- authority granted by this Section.
- 14 (e) The moneys received from the sale of property under
- this Section shall be used to satisfy the State debt related to
- 16 the Thomson Correctional Center. After satisfying that debt,
- the balance of the moneys received from the sale of property
- 18 under this Section shall be deposited into the General Revenue
- 19 Fund.
- 20 (f) The provisions of this Section apply and control
- 21 notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any other
- law to the contrary.
- 23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 24 becoming law.
