

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Sections 5.786, 5.787, 6z-87, and 6z-88 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.786 new)

7 Sec. 5.786. The Illinois State Crime Stoppers Association
8 Fund.

9 (30 ILCS 105/5.787 new)

10 Sec. 5.787. The After-School Rescue Fund.

11 (30 ILCS 105/6z-87 new)

12 Sec. 6z-87. Illinois State Crime Stoppers Association
13 Fund. The Illinois State Crime Stoppers Association Fund is
14 created as a special fund in the State treasury. Subject to
15 appropriation, the Fund shall be used by the Criminal Justice
16 Information Authority to make grants to the Illinois State
17 Crime Stoppers Association to enhance and develop Crime
18 Stoppers programs in Illinois.

19 (30 ILCS 105/6z-88 new)

20 Sec. 6z-88. After-School Rescue Fund; creation. The

1 After-School Rescue Fund is created as a special fund in the
2 State treasury. Moneys in the Fund shall be used by the
3 Illinois State Board of Education for the making of grants to
4 at-risk schools for the promotion of extracurricular and
5 after-school programs.

6 Section 10. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by
7 adding Sections 507YY and 507ZZ as follows:

8 (35 ILCS 5/507YY new)

9 Sec. 507YY. Crime Stoppers checkoff. For taxable years
10 ending on or after December 31, 2011, the Department shall
11 print, on its standard individual income tax form, a provision
12 indicating that, if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the
13 Illinois State Crime Stoppers Association Fund, as authorized
14 by this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, then he or
15 she may do so by stating the amount of the contribution (not
16 less than \$1) on the return and indicating that the
17 contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the
18 amount of payment to accompany the return. The taxpayer's
19 failure to remit any amount of the increased payment reduces
20 the contribution accordingly. This Section does not apply to
21 any amended return.

22 (35 ILCS 5/507ZZ new)

23 Sec. 507ZZ. After-School Rescue Fund checkoff. For taxable

1 years ending on or after December 31, 2011, the Department must
2 print on its standard individual income tax form a provision
3 (i) indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the
4 After-School Rescue Fund, as authorized by this amendatory Act
5 of the 97th General Assembly, he or she may do so by stating
6 the amount of the contribution (not less than \$1) on the return
7 and (ii) stating that the contribution will reduce the
8 taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to
9 accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased
10 payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly. This
11 Section does not apply to any amended return.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
13 becoming law.
