2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2315 by deleting 3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with 4 the following:

# "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the 7 purposes of this Act, the term "operational expenses" 8 includes the following items:

- 5 (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
- 6 (1) Refunds;
- 7 (m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;
- 8 (n) Permanent improvements;
- 9 (o) Deposits to other funds.

# ARTICLE 2

11 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 13 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 14 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 15 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 16 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 17 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 18 19 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of 20 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 21 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

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Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in

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Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a
voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The
voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate
or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case
may be.

6 Section 15. The amount of \$20,073,837 or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet ordinary 8 and incidental expenses of the the Senate 9 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and 10 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general and office operations. Of this amount, 25.07% 11 staff is 12 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 13 expenditures, 25.07% is appropriated to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures and 24.43% is appropriated to 14 15 the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 24.43% is 16 the House Minority Leader appropriated to for such 17 expenditures.

18 Section 20. Of this amount, 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

5 Section 25. The amount of \$298,490, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 6 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 7 8 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, 9 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law 10 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended 11 12 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such 13 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of 14 15 Representatives. Of this amount, 68.175% is appropriated to 16 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 31.825% appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such 17 is 18 expenditures.

19 Section 30. 1 special studies and long range research projects which may be requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 2 of Representatives for Standing House Committees 3 House pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 4 5 this amount, 45.587% is appropriated to 1984. Of the 6 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 54.413% is to the Speaker of the House 7 appropriated for such 8 expenditures.

9 Section 35. The amount of \$158,650, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for 11 12 allowances for the particular and additional services 13 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President 14 15 of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated 16 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.

Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield of members on official legislative business during weeks when the General Assembly is not in session. Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof 3 may necessary and remains unexpended 4 be from as an 5 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 45 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 6 7 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the 8 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and 9 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

17 Section 55.
