- 12 associated with Home Delivered Meals (formula and non-formula).
- 13 Section 70. In addition to amounts previously
- appropriated for this purpose, the sum of \$18,252,100, or so
- much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
- 16 General Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for grants
- 17 and for administrative expenses associated with the purchase
- of services covered by the Community Care Program, including
- 19 prior year costs.
