1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2458

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2458, AS AMENDED,  
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the  
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The amount of \$10,806,400, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Personal  
7 Property Tax Replacement Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
8 Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 for  
9 Regional Superintendents' and Assistants' Compensation and  
10 Related Benefits.

11 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much  
12 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
13 State Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July  
14 1, 2011:

3 Section 15. "An Act making appropriations", Public Act 97-  
4 56 is amended by changing Section 10 of Article 5 as follows:

8 State Comptroller to pay certain appointed officers of the
