

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB2500

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/1-10.5 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that as a condition of initial eligibility for any benefits under the Code, an applicant must pass a drug screening. Provides that as a condition of continued eligibility for benefits, a recipient must pass random drug screenings as prescribed by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Exempts residents of a facility licensed under the Nursing Home Care Act from the drug screening requirements. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 1-10.5 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/1-10.5 new)
- Sec. 1-10.5. Drug screening. As a condition of initial
 eligibility for any benefits under this Code, an applicant must
 pass a drug screening. As a condition of continued eligibility
 for any benefits under this Code, a recipient must pass random
 drug screenings as prescribed by the Department of Human
 Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services.
- The drug screening required by this Section does not apply to
- 14 residents of a facility licensed under the Nursing Home Care
- 15 <u>Act.</u>
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 17 becoming law.
