AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources
(Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois
is amended by changing Section 805-40 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 805/805-40) (was 20 ILCS 805/63a41)

8 Sec. 805-40. Adopt-A-Park program. The Department shall 9 may establish and maintain Adopt-A-Park programs with individual or group volunteers, if requested by an individual 10 or group volunteers, in an effort to reduce and remove litter 11 12 from parks and park lands and to provide other services. The Department shall retain the ability to approve or deny an 13 14 individual or group volunteer's request; however, the Department must state the reason for the request denial. These 15 16 programs shall include but not be limited to the following:

(1) Providing and coordinating services by volunteers
to reduce the amount of litter, including providing trash
bags and trash bag pickup and, in designated areas where
volunteers may be in close proximity to moving vehicles.
<u>Individuals or volunteers must bring their own</u>, providing
safety briefings and reflective safety gear.

(2) The Department shall provide a certificate of

1appreciation to individual or group volunteers as2recognition of their Adopt-A-Park efforts at a particular3Department site.4identifying those volunteers adopting particular parks and5park lands.

6 <u>(3) Volunteer services shall not include work</u> 7 <u>historically performed by Department employees, including</u> 8 <u>services that result in a reduction of hours or</u> 9 <u>compensation or that may be performed by an employee on</u> 10 <u>layoff; nor shall volunteer services be inconsistent with</u> 11 the terms of a collective bargaining agreement.

12 The State and the Department, its directors, employees, and agents shall not be liable for any damages or injury suffered 13 14 by any person resulting from his or her participation in the program or from the actions or activities of the volunteers, 15 16 except in cases of willful and wanton misconduct. Any group and its individual members who wish to volunteer or any individual 17 who wishes to volunteer is required to execute a general 18 19 release and hold harmless agreement before beginning any 20 volunteer activity or work. An officer, director, or other 21 representative of any group shall also be required to execute a 22 general release and hold harmless on behalf of a group. The 23 agreement shall be prepared and provided by the Department. 24 By engaging in volunteer activities under this Act,

1 <u>type, including benefits, nor (2) creation of an</u> 2 <u>employer-employee relationship. The Prevailing Wage Act and</u> 3 <u>the administrative rules adopted thereunder, 56 Ill. Adm. Code</u> 4 <u>100, shall not apply to any Department project or job in which</u> 5 <u>volunteers are utilized under the Adopt-A-Park program.</u> 6 (Source: P.A. 90-14, eff. 7-1-97; 91-239, eff. 1-1-00.) 7 Section 99.
