Amends the Counties Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the county clerk as the recorder.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 3-5001 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/3-5001) (from Ch. 34, par. 3-5001)
- 7 Sec. 3-5001. County clerk as recorder; election of
- 8 recorder. The county clerk in in counties having a population
- 9 of less than 60,000 inhabitants shall be the recorder in his
- 10 county.
- In counties having a population of 60,000 or more
- inhabitants, there shall be elected a recorder, as provided by
- 13 law, who shall hold his office until his successor is
- 14 qualified.
- 15 If the population of any county in which a recorder has
- been elected decreases to less than 60,000, the voters of that
- 17 county shall continue to elect a recorder if the county board
- 18 adopts a resolution to continue the office of an elected
- 19 recorder.
