physically or electronically integrated into the motor

- 1 "Electronic message" means a self-contained piece of digital communication that is designed or intended to be 2 transmitted between physical devices. "Electronic message" 3 4 includes, but is not limited to electronic mail, a text 5 message, an instant message, or a command or request to access an Internet site. 6
- 7 (b) A person may not operate a motor vehicle on a roadway 8 while using an electronic communication device to compose, 9 send, or read an electronic message.
 - (b-5) A person operating a motor vehicle on a roadway may not take a digital photograph or video within 500 feet of an emergency scene where an authorized emergency vehicle is present and making use of audible or visual signals as described in Section 11-907 of this Code.
 - (c) A violation of this Section is an offense against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles.
 - (d) This Section does not apply to:
 - (1) a law enforcement officer or operator of an emergency vehicle while performing his or her official duties:
 - (2) a driver using an electronic communication device for the sole purpose of reporting an emergency situation and continued communication with emergency personnel during the emergency situation;
 - (3) a driver using an electronic communication device in hands-free or voice-activated mode;

- (5) a driver using an electronic communication device while parked on the shoulder of a roadway; or
- (6) a driver using an electronic communication device when the vehicle is stopped due to normal traffic being obstructed and the driver has the motor vehicle transmission in neutral or park.
