SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/2.25

from Ch. 61, par. 2.25

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that the Director of the Department of Natural Resources shall establish an additional shotgun, handgun, or muzzleloading rifle 3-day season for counties that include or are North of interstate I-88 that have deer herds affected with chronic wasting disease. Provides the Director may establish an additional shotgun, handgun, or muzzleloading rifle 3-day season for counties South of interstate I-88 where the Director deems a significant number of deer herds are affected with chronic wasting disease.

1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section 2.25 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.25) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.25)

7 Sec. 2.25. It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer 8 except (i) with a shotgun, handgun, or muzzleloading rifle or 9 (ii) as provided by administrative rule, with a bow and arrow, or crossbow device for handicapped persons, as defined in 10 Section 2.33, and persons age 62 or older during the open 11 season of not more than 14 days which will be set annually by 12 the Director between the dates of November 1st and December 13 14 31st, both inclusive, or a special 2-day, youth-only season between the dates of September 1 and October 31. The Director 15 16 shall establish an additional shotqun, handqun, or 17 muzzleloading rifle 3-day season for counties that include or are North of interstate I-88 that have deer herds affected with 18 19 chronic wasting disease. The Director may establish an additional shotgun, handgun, or muzzleloading rifle 3-day 20 21 season for counties South of interstate I-88 where the Director 22 deems a significant number of deer herds are affected with chronic wasting disease. 23

For the purposes of this Section, legal handguns include any centerfire handguns of .30 caliber or larger with a minimum barrel length of 4 inches. The only legal ammunition for a centerfire handgun is a cartridge of .30 caliber or larger with a capability of at least 500 foot pounds of energy at the muzzle. Full metal jacket bullets may not be used to harvest deer.

The Department shall make administrative rules concerning management restrictions applicable to the firearm and bow and arrow season.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except with a bow and arrow, or crossbow device for handicapped persons, as defined in Section 2.33, and persons age 62 or older during the open season for bow and arrow set annually by the Director between the dates of September 1st and January 31st, both inclusive.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except with (i) a muzzleloading rifle, or (ii) bow and arrow, or crossbow device for handicapped persons, as defined in Section 2.33, and persons age 62 or older during the open season for muzzleloading rifles set annually by the Director.

The Director shall cause an administrative rule setting forth the prescribed rules and regulations, including bag and possession limits and those counties of the State where open seasons are established, to be published in accordance with Sections 1.3 and 1.13 of this Act.

The Department may establish separate harvest periods for the purpose of managing or eradicating disease that has been found in the deer herd. This season shall be restricted to gun or bow and arrow hunting only. The Department shall publicly announce, via statewide news release, the season dates and shooting hours, the counties and sites open to hunting, permit requirements, application dates, hunting rules, legal weapons, and reporting requirements.

Department is authorized to establish a separate harvest period at specific sites within the State for the purpose of harvesting surplus deer that cannot be taken during the regular season provided for the taking of deer. This season shall be restricted to gun or bow and arrow hunting only and shall be established during the period of September 1st to February 15th, both inclusive. The Department shall publish suitable prescribed rules and regulations established by administrative rule pertaining to management restrictions applicable to this special harvest program. The Department shall allow unused gun deer permits that are left over from a regular season for the taking of deer to be rolled over and used during any separate harvest period held within 6 months of the season for which those tags were issued at no additional the permit holder subject to the to management restrictions applicable to the special harvest program.
