## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, From the 19th century to the present, the Rock 3 Island Arsenal has been a part of the economic and government 4 service history of the Quad Cities; and

5 WHEREAS, From an employment peak of 18,467 during the 6 height of World War II, the arsenal's workforce has shrunk to 7 less than half that number; and

8 WHEREAS, The arsenal remains a major economic engine in the 9 region, with more than 8,500 employees and more than 70 federal 10 and commercial tenants; the arsenal also adds some \$1 billion 11 to the local economy and impacts 14,000 community jobs; and

12 WHEREAS, The Joint Manufacturing and Technology Center at 13 the arsenal is one of the world's largest weapons manufacturing 14 facilities; the arsenal and its employees have repeatedly 15 proven that, for small-quantity orders and specialty jobs, it 16 has the expertise, equipment, and dedication to the defense of 17 the United States that cannot be equaled in private industry; 18 and

WHEREAS, A reduction at the Rock Island Arsenal would not only threaten the local economy, but would also jeopardize the readiness of United States forces to quickly respond in the war SJ0059 -2- LRB097 20631 GRL 66479 r on terror or in any future conflict; therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL 3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 4 CONCURRING HEREIN, that we urge the President of the United 5 States, the United States Congress, and the Secretary of the 6 Department of Defense to protect the Rock Island Arsenal from 7 any future reductions or other budget cuts; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this Resolution be 9 delivered to the President of the United States, the Secretary 10 of the United States Department of Defense, and the members of 11 the Illinois congressional delegation.
