SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Prohibits a person from holding the office of State Senator or State Representative, or a combination of those offices, for more than 10 years. Effective upon being declared adopted.

3 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 4 5 CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the 6 electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of 7 8 this resolution a proposition to amend the Illinois 9 Constitution by adding Section 2.5 to Article IV as follows:

- 10 ARTICLE IV
- 11 THE LEGISLATURE
- 12 (ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new)
- 13 SECTION 2.5. TERM LIMITS

14 <u>No person may hold the office of State Senator or State</u> 15 <u>Representative, or a combination of those offices, for more</u> 16 than 10 consecutive years.
