5 WHEREAS, He was born on August 14, 1923, in Eldorado, the 6 son of W. Floyd and Muriel (Williams) Stephenson; he married 7 Lucille "Lucy" Stephenson on February 9, 1947, in Fosterburg 8 and she preceded him in death; and

WHEREAS, He started his employment at Olin as a guard until he joined the United States Army, where he served his country during World War II from 1943 until 1946; upon returning from the war, he became an insurance agent for Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, and retired from there; he then helped Dugger Pool in Bethalto as a pool installer and helped with maintenance; and

WHEREAS, He proudly served as the mayor of the village of Bethalto from 1981 to 1997; he was a member of the Bethalto United Methodist Church, charter member of the Bethalto Spirit Group, a 50-year member of the Masonic Brotherhood, a member of the Bethalto American Legion Post 214, and the Bethalto Rotary Club, where he held the honor of being a Paul Harris Fellow; and
