WHEREAS, On December 17, 1968, Illinois State Police officer Floyd J. Farrar was assisting a motorist with a flat tire on Illinois Route 103 when he was struck by a second vehicle traveling in the opposite direction; the impact killed Trooper Farrar instantly; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Farrar served his country with pride and distinction in the United States military during World War II; he began his career with the Illinois State Police on October 4, 1945 and served with integrity for 23 years before his untimely death; and
