WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 2 3 learn of the death of Joseph J. Gentile, who passed away on 4 October 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, He was born in Chicago, grew up on the Near West Side, and was a longtime resident of the Western suburbs his 7 entire life; he was a graduate of St. Ignatius and attended the University of Notre Dame before joining the United States Navy; 9 he served in the South Pacific theater during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Upon returning from the war, he received a degree in psychology from Loyola University in 1948; he taught briefly at the University, and then began a career as a car salesman; he opened a Chrysler and Plymouth dealership in Barrington in 1985 and was named "the Baron of Barrington"; he retired in 2003; and

16 WHEREAS, In 1994, he purchased an Elmhurst radio station and renamed it WJJG-AM, based on his initials; and 17

18 WHEREAS, He was a faithful supporter of St. Ignatius and 19 Loyola; in 1996, the basketball arena at Loyola was named the 20 Joseph J. Gentile Center in his honor; and
