15 WHEREAS, She served as secretary and treasurer for her 16 family business, Prince Castles/Cock Robin Companies from 1972 17 to 1985 and then at the Naperville Creamery Co. from 1985 to 18 2000; she volunteered at Edward Hospital as a member of the 19 Institutional Review Board; she was a member of the Fire and 20 Police Board of Commissioners for 8 years; and
