1 SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The life and presidency of President Abraham 2 3 Lincoln are integral to the identity and character of this 4 great nation; his sudden passing is an indelible mark upon 5 history; and 6 WHEREAS, Abraham Lincoln's statesmanship began in the 7 State of Illinois; following his establishment as a lawyer and 8 legislator, the State capital of Springfield became his home in 9 1837; and 10 WHEREAS, Springfield was the home of Lincoln's family until February 11, 1861, when he departed for Washington D.C. to 11 serve as the 16th President of the United States until his 12 13 death on April 15, 1865; and 14 President Lincoln's body was WHEREAS. returned Springfield on May 3, 1865, as the nation mourned his passing; 15 16 he was laid to rest at Oak Ridge Cemetery on May 4, 1865; and 17 WHEREAS, The Illinois Senate is compelled to acknowledge 18 and commend the exceptional effort to preserve and honor the legacy of Abraham Lincoln for this State and our nation; and 19

- 5 (1865-2015) is to educate, coordinate, and promote the accurate
- 6 and dignified reenactment of the historic anniversary of
- Abraham Lincoln's funeral procession in Springfield; and

- 9 symposiums starting in April of 2015 and culminate with the
- 10 reenactment of the original 1865 funeral during a 3-day
- 11 historic experience from May 1-3, 2015; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The event's symposiums and reenactment will serve
- as a valuable resource to inform, educate, and enlighten the
- 14 citizens of this State and the nation; therefore, be it
- 15 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL
- ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate the days
- of April 28, 2013 to May 4, 2013 as Abraham Lincoln Memorial
