2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2443, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with  
4 the following:

18 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$1,107,000, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
21 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as

1 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of  
2 higher education.

3 Section 40. The sum of \$792,200, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
5 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants  
6 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating  
7 nurses.

8 Section 45. The sum of \$162,000, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
10 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator  
11 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

12 Section 50. The sum of \$207000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
15 with the u.Select System.

16 Section 55. The sum of \$205,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
