  17 <u>regularly sells or serves a food item or meal on a school</u>
  18 <u>campus.</u>
- 19 <u>(b) The board must not make available to students food</u> 20 <u>containing industrially produced trans fat or use food</u> 21 <u>containing industrially produced trans fat in the preparation</u> 22 <u>of a food item served to students.</u>
