"AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public Act 97-0725, approved June 30, 2012, is amended by adding new 2 Section 46 to Article 20 as follows: 3 4 (P.A. 97-0725, Art. 20, Sec. 46 new) 5 6 Sec. 46. The sum of \$675,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Road Fund to the 7 8 Department of Transportation for preliminary engineering and 9 construction engineering and contract costs of construction, 10 including reconstruction, extension and improvement of state and local roads and bridges, fringe parking facilities and 11 such other purposes as provided by the "Illinois Highway 12 13 Code"; for purposes allowed or required by Title 23 of the U.S. Code; for bikeways as provided by Public Act 78-850; for 14 land acquisition and signboard removal and control and 15 16 preservation of natural beauty, in accordance with applicable 17 laws and regulations for the State and local portions of the 18 Road Improvement Program as approximated below-such 19 appropriations are in addition to those amounts already 20 enacted: 21 22 District 2, Dixon43,210,000 23 24
