2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 212, AS AMENDED, by
3 replacing the title with the following:

4 "AN ACT concerning appropriations."; and
5 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
6 following:

7 "ARTICLE 1

8 Section 1. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public
9 Act 97-0727, approved June 30, 2012, is amended by adding new
10 Section 6 to Article 23 as follows:

11 (P.A. 97-0727, Art. 23, Sec. 6 new)

12 Sec. 6. The sum of \$6,807,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
14 to the Department of Natural Resources for Personal Services

1 and State Contributions to Social Security, including prior
2 year costs, at the approximate costs below:

6 Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public

 21 including prior year costs, at the approximate costs below:
