## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

240 ILCS 40/1-5

Amends the Grain Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the purpose of the Code.

1 AN ACT concerning warehouses.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Grain Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 1-5 as follows:
- 6 (240 ILCS 40/1-5)
- 7 Sec. 1-5. Purpose. It is the the primary purpose of this 8 Code to promote the State's welfare by improving the economic 9 stability of agriculture through the existence of the Illinois 10 Grain Insurance Fund in order to protect producers in the event of the failure of a licensed grain dealer or 11 licensed warehouseman and to ensure the existence of 12 an adequate 13 resource so that persons holding valid claims mav be
- 14 compensated for losses occasioned by the failure of a licensed 15 grain dealer or licensed warehouseman. To that end, this Code
- shall be liberally construed and liberally administered in
- 17 favor of claimants.
- 18 In addition, the Illinois grain industry comprises a
- 19 significant and vital part of the State's economy and as such
- 20 can function to its fullest competitive and profitable
- 21 potential, thus contributing to the economic health of this
- 22 State, when it operates under a coordinated and integrated
- 23 regulatory structure. Thus, a further purpose of this Code is

- 1 to provide a single system of governmental regulation of the
- 2 Illinois grain industry.
